



Range/Scoring Rules

New rules highlighted in blue.

1. No archers allowed on the ranges until 8am Friday.
2. Competitors may not walk ranges or “scout” targets prior to shooting.
3. Range hours are 8am-8pm Friday/Saturday. No shooting allowed after ranges close.
4. Sunday range hours 8am-10am for competitors, 8am-noon for fun shooters.
5. No practice rounds. The first time ranges are shot must be for score.
6. Targets must be shot in numerical order, beginning with target #1.
7. Participants shall not walk about with an arrow nocked on the string.
8. Children under 16 must be accompanied by parent or guardian.
9. **Competitors may compete in only one class.**
10. Competitors must have some portion of their body touching the stake while shooting a target.
11. **Men/Women/Young Adults shoot from red stake.**
12. **Youths age 12 to 16 shoot from white stake.**
13. **Cubs/Chipmunks age 11 and under shoot from the blue stake.**
14. **Binoculars are permitted**; however, range finders are prohibited.
15. Any arrow shaft material may be used in the Recurve and Longbow classes; however, Primitive class must shoot wood or cane arrows.
16. **No release aids.** Competitors may use a tab or glove and must shoot split finger or three fingers under (Apache Draw).
17. Competitors must use a consistent anchor (**no “face walking”**) and one nocking point (**no “string walking”**).
18. No sights, marks or paint on bows to aid aiming.
19. Arrows must be shot off the bow shelf or hand (**no elevated rests**).
20. **No stabilizers** or counterweights on bow.
21. **Competitors need to submit their scorecards by 10am Sunday.**
22. Complaints/rule violations will be settled by the Rules Committee. Their decision is final.
